Based on helpful feedback from several of our fellow homeowners, the Colonia Encantada Landscape Committee and Board have developed this Worksheet for xeriscaping installation to help guide homeowners and expedite their requests to install xeriscape in the front yard, courtyard and/or back yard. The requirements reflect the community's desire to maintain landscaping with a consistent and cohesive look in front yards throughout the neighborhood, to recognize the interdependence of all plots given our shared irrigation system, and to accommodate the water scarcity situation facing all Scottsdale homeowners. In filling out this Worksheet, please refer to the attached instructions as well as to the Colonia Encantada Rules Regarding Artificial Turf and Xeriscaping found in the Landscape Guidelines on the Colonia Encantada website (www.coloniaencantada.net/gov-docs).

To complete your xeriscape approval application, please turn in all of the following documents to the Landscape Committee.

- --- A completed Worksheet for Xeriscape Approval
- --- A completed Request Form for Approval of Architectural and/or Landscape Changes
- --- A diagram of your xeriscape project with details about the area to be covered by rock, location of existing trees and shrubs, placement of plants, exactly which plants will be used, placement of boulders, placement of pavers, and all proposed irrigation changes.
- --- A sample from your vendor of the landscape rock to be used
- --- A paver sample, if applicable
- --- A brochure describing your boulder(s), if applicable
- --- Written acknowledgement from CLM that CLM has reviewed all proposed changes to the project's irrigation and drainage.

At maturity, plantings must cover at least 75% of the front yard xeriscaped area.

10. Irrigation and Drainage

- ---All irrigation changes and adjustments must be made or reviewed by CLM.
- ---Irrigation must be adequate and appropriate to maintain the health of existing trees and shrubs.
- ---Any trees that become dead or dying will need to be removed at the homeowner's expense, subject to prior Board approval. Additionally, dead or dying trees may need to be replaced at the homeowner's expense, if required by the Board.
- ---If your xeriscape project includes the removal of any trees, please so note on your application so that the Board will review and, if appropriate, approve your request at a regularly scheduled Board meeting before your project may begin.
- --- Drainage must be sufficient to avoid pooling and flooding.
